On November 4, 2002, Northern Region Hearing Board Chairman, Mr. Mark Kanai, Esq., approved an emergency variance effective from October 31, 2002, to November 29, 2002. Said variance provided relief from the requirements of District Rules 2070.7.0, and 4623 as they pertain to the continued operation of the subject floating roof tank until the tank can be taken out of service and the roof replaced.

B. <u>Docket # N-02-12E</u> – Pilkington North America 500 E. Louise Avenue, Lathrop, CA 95330

On November 15, 2002, Northern Region Hearing Board Chairman, Mr. Mark Kanai, Esq., approved an emergency variance effective from November 15, 2002, to November 29, 2002. Said variance provided relief from the requirements of District Rule 2070.7.0 as it pertains to continued facility operations without the use of the dust collector system and the release of excess PM emissions.

C. Docket # N-02-15E – US INTEC, Inc. 3301 N. Navone Road, Stockton, CA 95205

On December 23, 2002, Northern Region Hearing Board Chairman, Mr. Mark Kanai, Esq., approved an emergency variance effective from December 30, 2002, to January 28, 2003. Said variance provided relief from the requirements of District Rule 2010 and 2070.7.0 as they pertain to the operation of the subject asphalt plant with a modified afterburner inlet-piping configuration, pending installation of a new RTO unit.
