A.) Docket N-04-04S, Short Variance, California Dairies, Inc., 475 S. Tegner, Turlock, CA. 95380. Type of Business: Powdered Milk Processing Facility.

<u>Decision</u> – Board Member Benak made the motion to grant the variance request with the required six findings adopted by reference. The variance shall be subject to twelve recommendations with recommendation # 1 modified to a 60-day period and recommendation # 7 modified to read the petitioner shall surrender ERCs equal to 20% of actual emissions. Seconded by Board Member Schneider and carried unanimously with the following *Roll Call Vote:*

The Board granted a Short Variance to Docket N-04-04S, California Dairies, Inc. The variance shall be effective for a 60-day period to occur sometime between September 1, 2004 and November 30, 2004. The variance shall expire should the retrofit of Unit A be completed sooner or the FGR on Unit B achieve stable operation without excess NOx emissions. The variance is subject to twelve recommended conditions with recommendations # 1 and # 7 modified during the hearing. The twelve conditions with modifications will be set forth in the Hearing Board Order.
