A. Docket #S-05-27E – Chevron USA, Inc.

On March 25, 2005, Hearing Board Chairman Mr. Hollis B. Carlile approved an emergency variance effective from March 26, 2005, to March 27, 2005. Said variance provided relief from specific requirements of District Rules 2070.7.0, 2201, and 4623 to allow the storage of VOC containing liquids in 28 tanks without an operational vapor recovery system while PG&E curtails power to complete maintenance activities in the Twisselman Road area.
