- describe the science behind air pollution
- introduce you to the social, health and economic implications of air pollution
- show you how professionals with training in diverse backgrounds develop plans for cleaning the air and then implement and enforce those plans

# This program is designed for:

- current employees of businesses and agencies that deal with air quality issues on a regular basis
- prospective employees seeking air quality work with public agencies
- local elected and appointed officials (Council members, Planning Commissioners, special district Board members)
- · community members and environmental groups
- university students who wish to supplement their undergraduate studies in environmental science, environmental health, geography, or related fields

### Topics to be covered include:

- air quality management process
- permitting, compliance and regulatory issues
- design and evaluation of air pollution control equipment
- risk assessment and modeling
- regional decisions affecting air quality (land use, transportation, job creation)
- health, social, political and economic implications of air quality
- future challenges in air quality management in the San Joaquin Valley

Courses in the certificate program is scheduled to meet every other Friday, beginning September 22 – December 15, 2006 from 8 a.m. – 12 noon. The fee is \$395 per person and includes materials and supplies for all courses and the field trip on November 17.


