## Preliminary Review -Application Deemed Incomplete

- Letter of Incompleteness
- If unanswered...
  - Intent to Deny Application
  - Denial of Application
  - Applicant can appeal to the Hearing Board



### -Application Deemed Complete

"Complete Letter" sent, indicating District has all necessary info and application is ready for final application review






### **Application Review**

- 180 days (maximum) after:
  - receipt of complete application, or
  - after CEQA review is complete.

(whichever is later)





## NSR Requirements

- BACT (Best Available Control Technology)
- Emission Offsets



### BACT

- Best Available Control Technology
  - The best available control device or method to minimize emissions from an operation.
    - filters
    - scrubbers
    - material substitution: Low-VOC paints
    - equipment substitution: electrical motors vs. fuel-burning engines
  - Must be achieved in practice, or cost effective





### **Emission Offsets**

### **Public Notification**


- Notification may be required
  - New Source Review Notice (newspaper)
  - Proximity to School Notice (not published)
  - **EPA Notice**
- 30 or 45-day period






### **Final Action**

- Project Approval
  - Issuance of Authority to Construct
- Project Denial
  - Notice of Denial
  - Applicant can appeal to the Hearing Board


