California Environmental Protection Agency

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On February 28, 2014, ARB staff issued an AST EVR Regulatory Advisory that provides certain AST owners/operators with interim relief from the requirement to upgrade their tanks with Phase I EVR by July 1, 2014. Staff intends to present the Board with proposed regulatory amendments in November 2014 that would formally incorporate the terms of the Regulatory Advisory into regulation. The purpose of these workshops is to inform interested parties about the AST EVR Regulatory Advisory and to solicit feedback that can be incorporated into the November 2014 regulatory amendments. In the event that relief provided by the Regulatory Advisory differs from the regulatory amendments approved by the Board in November 2014, AST owners and operators will be provided additional time to comply, which would be specified in the final amendments.

Each workshop will consist of a one-hour presentation by staff, followed by a question and answer period. The staff presentation will include:

- Overview of the AST EVR Regulatory Advisory
- Explanation of ARB Staff's Rationale for Providing Exemptions for Certain ASTs
- Estimated Cost Savings and Emission Impacts
- Outline of the Rulemaking Process


Additional workshops will be scheduled in June 2014 where interested parties will have an opportunity to review and to provide comments on the proposed regulatory language. Interested parties will also have a final opportunity to comment on the proposed regulatory changes when they are presented to the Board for consideration during the November 2014 Hearing.
