

**NOTICE OF THE UPCOMING
TRAINING COURSE FOR THE
CERTIFICATION OF AIR PERMITTING PROFESSIONALS (CAPP)**

The San Joaquin Valley Air Pollution Control District (District) will be conducting a two-day training course for new CAPP candidates. The CAPP course is designed as a review of District permitting programs, policies and procedures for experienced environmental permitting professionals. Prior air permitting experience is required for acceptance into the CAPP program as detailed in District [Rule 1170, section 4.0](#).

The CAPP two-day course will be held at the following time and location:

May 19 & 20, 2014 (Monday and Tuesday)

To become CAPP certified, candidates must also pass a four-hour exam that will be given on Thursday, June 12, 2014 at 8:30 AM in Fresno. This is the only day the exam will be offered.

CAPP program candidates must send a complete CAPP training application form to the District by May 12, 2014 by 5:00 PM. Only the two-day mandatory CAPP course (\$374) will be offered. The District will review all applications and notify candidates if they are eligible to attend this training course. Class assignment is limited and will be based on the date of receipt of the complete application. Additionally, auditing the course is possible based on space availability.
