OPTIONS FOR DISTRICT IMPLEMENTATION OF CALIFORNIA AIR RESOURCES BOARD'S NEW REGULATION, "GREENHOUSE GAS EMISSION STANDARDS FOR CRUDE OIL AND NATURAL GAS FACILITIES"

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that a scoping meeting will be held to present, discuss, and receive input on District implementation options for the recently adopted CARB Greenhouse Gas Emission Standards for Crude Oil and Natural Gas Facilities Rule (find it here: <https://www.arb.ca.gov/cc/oil-gas/oil-gas.htm>).

On March 23, 2017 CARB adopted a new rule to establish greenhouse gas emission standards for oil and natural gas facilities. The District has received feedback from both CARB staff and the affected stakeholders that this new rule would best be implemented on a local level by the District, and this meeting is to begin the process of developing a District program to do so.

The scoping meeting will be presented in-person, via Video Conferencing (VTC), and via webcast to discuss District implementation options for this rule at the following date, time, and locations:
