The Air Pollution Control Officer has issued Emission Reduction Credits (ERCs) to Aera Energy, LLC for emission reductions generated by the shutdown of eight oil production tanks at the Maxwell Lease, at Aera's heavy crude oil production source in western Kern County. The quantity of ERCs to be issued is 65 pounds per year of volatile organic compounds (VOCs).

Enclosed is the ERC Certificate and a copy of the notice of final action to be published approximately three days from the date of this letter.

Notice of the District's preliminary decision to issue the ERC Certificates was published on September 24, 2009. The District's analysis of the proposal was also sent to CARB and US EPA Region IX on September 18, 2009. No comments were received following the District's preliminary decision on this project.
