

**NOTICE OF PRELIMINARY DECISION  
FOR THE PROPOSED ISSUANCE OF  
AUTHORITY TO CONSTRUCT**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the San Joaquin Valley Air Pollution Control District solicits public comment on the proposed issuance of Authority To Construct to Chevron USA, Inc. for its oil production facilities in the Heavy and Light Oil Western Stationary Sources, California. Chevron is proposing to modify a portable oilfield steam generator by adding flue gas recirculation to achieve 9 ppmvd-NOx @ 3% O2 and restate the SOx limit from 1.0 gr s/100 scf to the equivalent PUC quality limit of 0.00285 lb/MMBtu all for Rule 4320 compliance
