The facility is proposing to lower the NOx emissions limit for ten steam generators to comply with the requirements of District Rule 4320. Additionally, for five of the steam generators that are dual-fueled, the facility is proposing to lower SOx emissions by 95% by weight, also for Rule 4320 compliance.
