The Air Pollution Control Officer has issued Authority to Construct permits to Bolthouse Farms Inc. for a 250 bhp John Deere model 6068H serial no. PE6068H387829 tier 2 diesel-fired IC engine powering an agricultural irrigation pump, at Section 14, Township 21S, Range 16E, Kreyenhagen, Fresno County.

Enclosed are copies of the Authority to Construct permits and a copy of the notice of final action to be published approximately three days from the date of this letter.

Notice of the District's preliminary decision to issue this Authority to Construct was published on November 25, 2009. The District's analysis of the proposal was also sent to CARB on November 19, 2009. No comments were received following the District's preliminary decision on this project.

EQUIPMENT DESCRIPTION:

250 BHP JOHN DEERE MODEL 6068H SERIAL NO PE6068H387829 TIER 2 DIESEL-FIRED IC ENGINE POWERING AN AGRICULTURAL IRRIGATION PUMP (ENG #301)

CONDITIONS

- 1. This IC engine shall only be used for the growing of crops or raising of fowl or animals. [District Rule 2201, 4701, and 4702]
- 2. No air contaminant shall be released into the atmosphere which causes a public nuisance. [District Rule 4102]
- 3. Particulate matter emissions shall not exceed 0.1 grains/dscf in concentration. [District Rule 4201]
- 4. No air contaminant shall be discharged into the atmosphere for a period or periods aggregating more than three minutes in any one hour which is as dark as, or darker than, Ringelmann 1 or 20% opacity. [District Rule 4101]
- 5. The exhaust stack shall vent vertically upward. The vertical exhaust flow shall not be impeded by a rain cap (flapper ok), roof overhang, or any other obstruction. [District Rule 4102]
- 6. This engine shall be equipped with an operational nonresettable elapsed time meter or other APCO approved alternative. [District Rule 4702]
- 7. Operation of this engine shall not exceed 2,000 hours per year. [District Rule 2201]
- 8. Emissions from this IC engine shall not exceed any of the following limits: 4.7 g-NOx/bhp-hr, 2.6 g-CO/bhp-hr, or 0.2 g-VOC/bhp-hr. [District Rule 2201 and 4702, and 17 CCR 93115]

YOU MUST NOTIFY THE DISTRICT COMPLIANCE DIVISION AT (559) 230-5950 WHEN CONSTRUCTION IS COMPLETED AND PRIOR TO OPERATING THE EQUIPMENT OR MODIFICATIONS AUTHORIZED BY THIS AUTHORITY TO CONSTRUCT. This is NOT a PERMIT TO OPERATE. Approval or denial of a PERMIT TO OPERATE will be made after an inspection to verify that the equipment has been constructed in accordance with the approved plans, specifications and conditions of this Authority to Construct, and to determine if the equipment can be operated in compliance with all Rules and Regulations of the San Joaquin Valley Unified Air Pollution Control District. Unless construction has commenced pursuant to Rule 2050, this Authority to Construct shall expire and application shall be cancelled two years from the date of issuance. The applicant is responsible for complying with all laws, ordinances and regulations of all other governmental agencies which may pertain to the above equipment.

- 9. Emissions from this IC engine shall not exceed 0.15 g-PM10/bhp-hr based on US EPA certification using ISO 8178 test procedure. [District Rule District Rules 2201 and 4102, and 17 CCR 93115]
- 10. Only CARB certified diesel fuel containing not more than 0.0015% sulfur by weight is to be used. [District Rules 2201 and 4801 and 17 CCR 93115]
- 11. This engine shall be operated and maintained in proper operating condition as recommended by the engine manufacturer or emissions control system supplier. [District Rule 4702]
- 12. During periods of operation, the permittee shall monitor the operational characteristics of the engine as recommended by the manufacturer or emission control system supplier (for example: check engine fluid levels, battery, cables and connections; change engine oil and filters; replace engine coolant; and/or other operational characteristics as recommended by the manufacturer or supplier). [District Rule 4702]
- 13. The owner/operator shall maintain an engine operating log to demonstrate compliance. The engine operating log shall include, on a monthly basis, the following information: total hours of operation, type of fuel used, maintenance or modifications performed, monitoring data, and any other information necessary to demonstrate compliance. [District Rule 4702]
- 14. The permittee shall record the total time the engine operates, in hours per calendar year. [District Rule 2201]
- 15. All records shall be maintained and retained on-site for a minimum of five (5) years, and shall be made available for District inspection upon request. [District Rule 4702]
