**NOTICE OF FINAL DECISION
FOR THE ISSUANCE OF AUTHORITY TO CONSTRUCT**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the San Joaquin Valley Air Pollution Control District has made its final decision to issue Authorities to Construct to Chevron USA, Inc. for Light oil facility located at in the Light Oil Western Stationary Source, California. Chevron is proposing to modify a portable oilfield steam generator by adding flue gas recirculation to achieve 9 ppmvd-NOx @ 3% O₂ and restate the SO_x limit from 1.0 gr s/100 scf to the equivalent PUC quality limit of 0.00285 lb/MMBtu all for Rule 4320 compliance
