

**NOTICE OF PRELIMINARY DECISION  
FOR THE ISSUANCE OF AUTHORITY TO CONSTRUCT**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the San Joaquin Valley Air Pollution Control District solicits public comment on the proposed modification of Occidental of Elk Hills, Inc. for its gas plant near Tupman, CA, California. Occidental has proposed to delete the fugitive VOC content limits, recalculate and restate the fugitive VOC emissions based on 100% VOC, and delete the requirement to test the gas for VOC content for 51 permit units.

The District's analysis of the legal and factual basis for this proposed action, project #1094956, is available for public inspection at the District office at the address below. This will be the public's only opportunity to comment on the specific conditions of the modification. If requested by the public, the District will hold a public hearing regarding issuance of this modification.
