**NOTICE OF PRELIMINARY DECISION
FOR THE PROPOSED ISSUANCE OF
AUTHORITY TO CONSTRUCT**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the San Joaquin Valley Air Pollution Control District solicits public comment on the proposed issuance of Authority To Construct to Chevron USA, Inc. for its heavy oil facility in the Heavy Oil Western Stationary Source, California. Chevron is lowering SOx and NOx limits, adding flue gas recirculation (FGR) and low NOx burners as necessary on 41 steam generators to comply with Rule 4320.
