

**NOTICE OF PRELIMINARY DECISION
FOR THE PROPOSED ISSUANCE OF
AUTHORITY TO CONSTRUCT**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the San Joaquin Valley Air Pollution Control District solicits public comment on the proposed issuance of Authority To Construct to Chevron USA Inc for its McKittrick Cogeneration plant at the McKittrick Cogeneration plant within the heavy oil production stationary source in the western Kern County fields, California. The ATCs authorize installation of two 5.285 MW Solar Taurus gas turbine engine/cogeneration units, each with 40 MMBtu/hr duct burner, heat recovery steam generator, a Selective Catalytic Reduction (SCR) System, and an Oxidation Catalyst. These units will replace existing equipment and are being installed to achieve compliance with District Rule 4703.
