

**NOTICE OF PRELIMINARY DECISION

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the San Joaquin Valley Air Pollution Control District solicits public comment on the proposed issuance of Authority To Construct to Chevron USA Inc for its light oil production stationary source within the light oil production stationary source in the western Kern County fields, California. The ATC authorizes a thermally enhanced oil recovery (TEOR) operation with up to 130 wells operated with closed casing vents and ancillary equipment including permit exempt well testers, pressure vessels, and relief tank and optional sulfur removal system.
