**NOTICE OF PRELIMINARY DECISION
FOR THE PROPOSED MODIFICATION OF
FEDERALLY MANDATED OPERATING PERMIT**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the San Joaquin Valley Air Pollution Control District solicits public comment on the proposed modification of the Federally Mandated Operating Permit to Vintage Production California, LLC. for its Midway Sunset oilfield tank battery located within its Light Oil Western stationary source in Kern County, CA, California. Vintage Production is proposing to delete any tank throughput restrictions, vapor pressure limits, and vapor testing requirements from the permits while adding Rule 4623 I&M requirements, tank cleaning requirements, and change the method of calculating emissions to fugitive components.

This will be the public's only opportunity to comment on the specific conditions of the modification. If requested by the public, the District will hold a public hearing regarding issuance of this modification.
