**NOTICE OF FINAL DECISION
FOR THE ISSUANCE OF AUTHORITY TO CONSTRUCT AND
SIGNIFICANT MODIFICATION OF FEDERALLY
MANDATED OPERATING PERMIT**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the San Joaquin Valley Air Pollution Control District has made its final decision to issue an Authority to Construct (ATC) to Pacific Gas and Electric Company for its natural gas compressor station located at 34453 Plymouth Avenue in Avenal, California. This ATC authorizes the modification of one 791 bhp natural gas fired emergency standby internal combustion (IC) engine to remove its emergency standby status, allow operation up to 200 hours per year during any situation, and replace the non-selective catalytic reduction (NSCR) system with a new NSCR system.
