**NOTICE OF PRELIMINARY DECISION
FOR THE PROPOSED ISSUANCE OF
FEDERALLY MANDATED OPERATING PERMITS**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the San Joaquin Valley Air Pollution Control District solicits public comment on the revised proposed issuance of the Federally Mandated Operating permits to Berry Petroleum Company for its Heavy Oil Production Source located near Poso Creek in Kern County, California. Initial notice of preliminary decision was sent to EPA, ARB on March 9, 2011 and notice of preliminary decision was published in Bakersfield Californian on March 15, 2011. Changes to initial preliminary notice are being made per facility comments.

There are no emission changes associated with this proposed action. This will be the public's only opportunity to comment on the specific conditions of the proposed Federally Mandated Operating initial permits.
