The facility proposes to establish a specific limiting condition (SLC) that limits annual wine fermentation and storage emissions from all wine tanks at their facility to the Pre-Project Potential to Emit of the pre-project fermentation and storage capacities of the facility. In addition, the facility is re-rating their current 25 MMBtu/hr boiler to 17.5 MMBtu/hr for District Rule 4320 compliance.
