Notice is hereby given that the San Joaquin Valley Unified Air Pollution Control District (District) proposes to issue an Initial Study and Proposed Mitigated Negative Declaration for the following project:

PROJECT TITLE, LOCATION, AND DESCRIPTION

Project Title: New Juice Processing Facility for Sun Pacific/Califia Farms

Project Location: The Sun Pacific/Califia Farms Juice Processing Facility will be located at 33374 Lerdo Hwy in Bakersfield, California.

Description of Project: Sun Pacific/Califia Farms is proposing to construct a new 48,000 square foot juice processing facility on a total of 6.8 acres. The project will add approximately 32 employees to the operation (over 3 shifts) and will result in an average of 25 additional round truck trips per day.

AVAILABILITY OF INITIAL STUDY AND PROPOSED NEGATIVE DECLARATION:

The Proposed Mitigated Negative Declaration demonstrates that with implementation of identified mitigation measures, project design elements and District permit conditions, the environmental impacts are less than significant. The reasons to support such a finding are documented in the Initial Study and Proposed Mitigated Negative Declaration prepared by the District.
