

**NOTICE OF PRELIMINARY DECISION
FOR THE ISSUANCE OF AUTHORITY TO CONSTRUCT AND
THE PROPOSED SIGNIFICANT MODIFICATION OF FEDERALLY
MANDATED OPERATING PERMIT**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the San Joaquin Valley Air Pollution Control District solicits public comment on the proposed significant modification of Berry Petroleum Company for its heavy oil facility within the Heavy Oil Western Stationary Source (Sec 21, T 30S, R 22E), California. Berry has requested to install a 85.0 MMBtu/hr natural gas fired steam generator (S-1326-352-0) and modify a Thermally Enhanced Oil Recovery (TEOR) system (-179-11) to include the new steam generator (-352-0) as an additional VOC disposal device.

This will be the public's only opportunity to comment on the specific conditions of the modification. If requested by the public, the District will hold a public hearing regarding issuance of this modification.
