<b>Description of Project:</b> This is a rule development project to amend existing District 4682 (Polystyrene, Polyethylene, and Polypropylene Products Manufacturing). The proposed project includes the following administrative amendments: Section 3.0, remove and add definitions; and Section 5.3.1, to bifurcate the requirements for extrusion and expandable polystyrene molding facilities; proposed Section 5.2.2 (which will apply to extrusion facilities) proposes to maintain the 2.4 pounds of VOC per 100 pounds of throughput limit, calculated monthly and Section 5.2.3 (for EPS facilities), proposes a daily limit of 3.4 pounds of VOC per 100 pounds of throughput while maintaining the current monthly limit of 2.4 pounds of VOC per 100 pounds of throughput.

Reasons Why Project is Exempt: The project is an amendment to existing District Rule 4682 (Polystyrene, Polyethylene, and Polypropylene Products Manufacturing). The amendments to Sections 3.0 and 5.3.1 are administrative. The District prepared a Staff Report, incorporated herein by reference and concludes that implementation of the proposed amendments would not result in foreseeable changes in existing operating practices impacting environmental resources. Thus, the District finds that the project is exempt per the general rule that CEQA applies only to projects which have the potential for causing a significant effect on the environment (CCR §15061(b)(3)).
