The Air Pollution Control Officer has issued Emission Reduction Credits (ERCs) to Crimson Resource Management for emission reductions generated by shutting down and replacing two natural gas-fired engines serving hydraulic well pumps (S-2918-37 & '-38) with electrical motors, at the Greely Lease within Crimson's Kern County Light Oil Central stationary source. The quantity of ERCs to be issued is 52 lb-VOC/year, 18 lb-NOx/year, and 850 lb-CO/year.

Enclosed are the ERC Certificates and a copy of the notice of final action to be published approximately three days from the date of this letter.

Notice of the District's preliminary decision to issue the ERC Certificates was published on October 6, 2010. The District's analysis of the proposal was also sent to CARB and US EPA Region IX on October 4, 2010. No comments were received following the District's preliminary decision on this project.

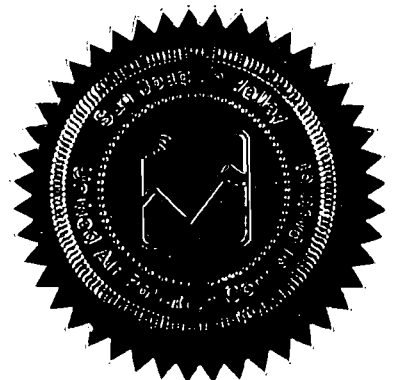

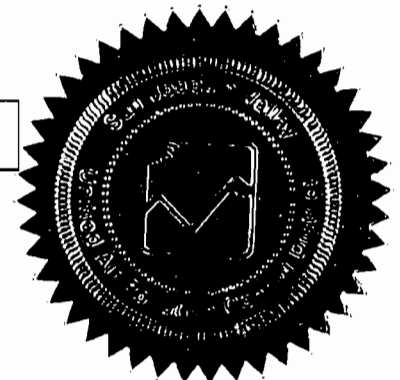

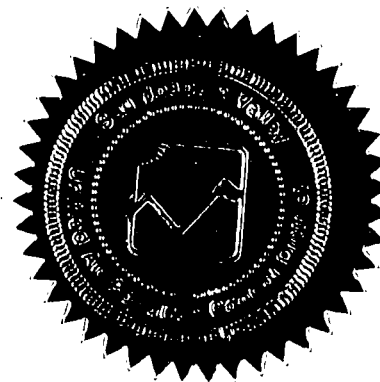
