

**NOTICE OF PRELIMINARY DECISION  
FOR THE ISSUANCE OF AUTHORITY TO CONSTRUCT AND  
THE PROPOSED SIGNIFICANT MODIFICATION OF FEDERALLY  
MANDATED OPERATING PERMIT**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the San Joaquin Valley Air Pollution Control District solicits public comment on the proposed significant modification of Vintage Production California, LLC for its heavy oil central facility, (Sections: 23, 24, 25 and 26, Township: 28S, Range: 27E), California. Vintage is proposing to modify the TEOR operation by increasing the well count to 1,085 wells, expanding the operation into Sections: 24, 25 and 26, Township: 28S, Range: 27E, and removing Rule 4401 Inspection and Re-inspection conditions (per exemption Rule 4401, Section 4.7).

There are no emission increases associated with this proposed action. This will be the public's only opportunity to comment on the specific conditions of the modification.
