

**NOTICE OF PRELIMINARY DECISION
FOR THE ISSUANCE OF AUTHORITY TO CONSTRUCT AND
THE PROPOSED SIGNIFICANT MODIFICATION OF FEDERALLY
MANDATED OPERATING PERMIT**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the San Joaquin Valley Air Pollution Control District solicits public comment on the proposed significant modification of The Wine Group, Inc. for its winery in Lodi, California. The Wine Group proposes the installation of 30 new wine fermentation and storage tanks

The District's analysis of the legal and factual basis for this proposed action, project #N-1120314, is available for public inspection at http://www.valleyair.org/notices/public_notices_idx.htm and the District office at the address below. There is no increase in the Potential to Emit for the facility associated with this proposed action. However, the proposed new emissions units individually have a Potential to Emit of 110 tons of VOC per year. This will be the public's only opportunity to comment on the specific conditions of the modification. If requested by the public, the District will hold a public hearing regarding issuance of this modification.
