

**NOTICE OF PRELIMINARY DECISION  
FOR THE ISSUANCE OF AUTHORITY TO CONSTRUCT AND  
THE PROPOSED SIGNIFICANT MODIFICATION OF FEDERALLY  
MANDATED OPERATING PERMIT**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the San Joaquin Valley Air Pollution Control District solicits public comment on the proposed significant modification of General Mills Operations for its cereal manufacturing facility at 2000 W. Turner Road in Lodi, California. The proposal is to lower the NO<sub>x</sub> emissions from the boiler to 7 ppmvd @ 3% O<sub>2</sub> for compliance with District Rule 4320. The lower NO<sub>x</sub> emissions will be accompanied by an increase in the CO emission limit to provide the tuning flexibility necessary to reliably meet the lower NO<sub>x</sub> limit.
