

**NOTICE OF FINAL DECISION  
FOR THE ISSUANCE OF AUTHORITY TO CONSTRUCT AND  
THE PROPOSED SIGNIFICANT MODIFICATION OF FEDERALLY  
MANDATED OPERATING PERMIT**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the San Joaquin Valley Air Pollution Control District has made its final decision to issue Authorities to Construct to Berry Petroleum Company for heavy oil production stationary source located in the western Kern County fields, California. The project authorizes installation of a 85 MMBtu/hr natural/TEOR/TVR gas-fired steam generator and modification of a thermally enhanced oil recovery (TEOR) operation to allow vapors to be combusted in the new steam generator.
