

**NOTICE OF FINAL DECISION
FOR THE ISSUANCE OF AUTHORITY TO CONSTRUCT AND
THE PROPOSED SIGNIFICANT MODIFICATION OF FEDERALLY
MANDATED OPERATING PERMIT**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the San Joaquin Valley Air Pollution Control District has made its final decision to issue Authorities to Construct to Berry Petroleum Company for heavy oil facility located located at the Midway Sunset oilfield within Berry's Heavy Oil Western Stationary Source (SE/4 Sec 36, T 12N, R 24W), California. The modification consisted of the installation of a 85.0 MMBtu/hr natural gas fired steam generator (S-1246-354-0) and the modification of a Thermally Enhanced Oil Recovery (TEOR) system (-290-6) to include the new steam generator as an additional VOC disposal device.
