

**NOTICE OF PRELIMINARY DECISION  
FOR THE ISSUANCE OF AUTHORITY TO CONSTRUCT AND  
THE PROPOSED SIGNIFICANT MODIFICATION OF FEDERALLY  
MANDATED OPERATING PERMIT**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the San Joaquin Valley Air Pollution Control District solicits public comment on the proposed significant modification of Delicato Vineyards for its winery located as 12001 South Highway 99, Manteca, California. This project is to install eight 154,000 gallon (each), ten 60,000 gallon (each), four 25,000 gallon (each), eight 13,000 gallon (each), and four 7,000 gallon (each) stainless steel wine fermentation and storage tanks.
