

**NOTICE OF PRELIMINARY DECISION
FOR THE ISSUANCE OF AUTHORITY TO CONSTRUCT AND
THE PROPOSED SIGNIFICANT MODIFICATION OF FEDERALLY
MANDATED OPERATING PERMIT**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the San Joaquin Valley Air Pollution Control District solicits public comment on the proposed significant modification of Bear Creek Winery at 11900 N Furry Road, Lodi, California. Bear Creek Winery is proposing to install eight new 62,000 gallon red/white wine tanks that will be used for both the fermentation and storage of wine.

There are no emission increases associated with this proposed action. This will be the public's only opportunity to comment on the specific conditions of the modification.
