

**NOTICE OF PRELIMINARY DECISION  
FOR THE ISSUANCE OF AUTHORITY TO CONSTRUCT AND  
THE PROPOSED SIGNIFICANT MODIFICATION OF FEDERALLY  
MANDATED OPERATING PERMIT**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the San Joaquin Valley Air Pollution Control District solicits public comment on the proposed significant modification of Northern California Power Agency at 12745 North Thornton Road, Lodi, California. This project is to increase the hourly CO startup and shutdown emissions, establish combustor tuning period, and to modify fuel flow meter requirements to match with the fuel flow scheme used for the gas turbine.

The District's analysis of the legal and factual basis for this proposed action, project #N-1130201, is available for public inspection at [http://www.valleyair.org/notices/public\\_notices\\_idx.htm](http://www.valleyair.org/notices/public_notices_idx.htm) and at any District office. The hourly CO emission increase is not expected to cause any significant health risks to the nearby receptors or violate the ambient air quality standard. This will be the public's only opportunity to comment on the specific conditions of the modification. If requested, the District will hold a public hearing regarding issuance of this modification.
