The Air Pollution Control Officer has issued Emission Reduction Credits (ERCs) to Britz Gin Partnership for emission reductions generated by the shutdown of a cotton gin, at 16423 W. Kamm Avenue in Helm, CA. The quantity of ERCs to be issued is 344 metric tons of CO<sub>2</sub>e per year.

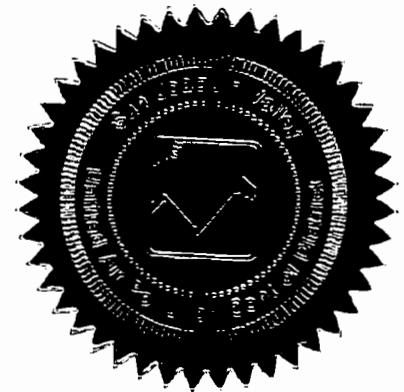
