NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the San Joaquin Valley Air Pollution Control District has made its final decision to issue an Authority to Construct to Occidental of Elk Hills at the 11G office in the SE/4 of Section 11, Township 30S, Range 23E, California, California. Occidental of Elk Hills is proposing to install a 755 bhp diesel-fired emergency standby internal combustion engine powering an electrical generator.

No comments were received following the District's preliminary decision on this project.
