NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the San Joaquin Valley Unified Air Pollution Control District solicits public comment on the proposed issuance of Emission Reduction Credits to Farmer's Cooperative Gin for the shutdown of a cotton gin, at 18451 Beech Avenue in Shafter, CA. The quantity of ERCs proposed for banking is 351 metric tons CO<sub>2</sub>e/yr.
