EMISSION REDUCTION CREDITS**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the San Joaquin Valley Unified Air Pollution Control District solicits public comment on the proposed issuance of Emission Reduction Credits to H.J Heinz Company for shutdown of the entire facility, at 2800 South El Dorado Street in Stockton, California. The quantity of ERCs proposed for banking is 229 lb-NOx/yr, 19 lb-SOx/yr, 239 lb-PM10/yr, 13 lb-CO/yr, and 173 lb-VOC/yr.
