**NOTICE OF PRELIMINARY DECISION
FOR THE ISSUANCE OF AUTHORITY TO CONSTRUCT AND
THE PROPOSED SIGNIFICANT MODIFICATION OF FEDERALLY
MANDATED OPERATING PERMIT**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the San Joaquin Valley Air Pollution Control District solicits public comment on the proposed significant modification of Equilon Enterprises, LLC at 3515 Navy Drive, Stockton, California. This project involves modifications to permits for storage and loading equipment at a gasoline bulk terminal.

The District's analysis of the legal and factual basis for this proposed action, project #N-1123247, is available for public inspection at http://www.valleyair.org/notices/public_notices_idx.htm and at any District office. The emissions increase from the project is not expected to cause any significant health risks to the nearby receptors. This will be the public's only opportunity to comment on the specific conditions of the modification. If requested, the District will hold a public hearing regarding issuance of this modification.
