

**NOTICE OF PRELIMINARY DECISION  
FOR THE ISSUANCE OF AUTHORITY TO CONSTRUCT AND  
THE PROPOSED SIGNIFICANT MODIFICATION OF FEDERALLY  
MANDATED OPERATING PERMIT**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the San Joaquin Valley Air Pollution Control District solicits public comment on the proposed significant modification of Sutter Home Winery at 18667 N. Jacob Brack Rd., Lodi, California. The proposed project includes the installation of 44 insulated and jacketed stainless steel wine storage tanks with the following capacities: 7,500 gallons (4 tanks); 15,000 gallons (4 tanks); 20,000 gallons (4 tanks); 30,000 gallons (6 tanks); 40,000 gallons (8 tanks); 60,000 gallons (6 tanks); 100,000 gallons (4 tanks); 120,000 gallons (4 tanks), and 200,000 gallons (4 tanks).

There are no emission increases associated with this proposed action. This will be the public's only opportunity to comment on the specific conditions of the modification.
