**NOTICE OF PRELIMINARY DECISION  
FOR THE ISSUANCE OF AUTHORITY TO CONSTRUCT AND  
THE PROPOSED SIGNIFICANT MODIFICATION OF FEDERALLY  
MANDATED OPERATING PERMIT**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the San Joaquin Valley Air Pollution Control District solicits public comment on the proposed significant modification of Vintage Production California, LLC at NE/4 Section 18, Township 28S, Range 20E, California. This project is to increase the flared gas throughput limit, to revise the sulfur monitoring frequency from once every 12 months to once annually, install sulfur removal vessels, and remove the reference to permit S-1738-422.
