**NOTICE OF FINAL DECISION
FOR THE ISSUANCE OF AUTHORITY TO CONSTRUCT AND
THE PROPOSED SIGNIFICANT MODIFICATION OF FEDERALLY
MANDATED OPERATING PERMIT**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Air Pollution Control Officer has issued the Authority to Construct permits to Equilon Enterprises, LLC for a proposal to increase throughput for storage and loading equipment at a gasoline bulk terminal, at 3515 Navy Drive, Stockton, California.

All comments received following the District's preliminary decision on this project were considered.

Comments received by the District during the public notice period resulted in minor changes to the proposed permits including correcting typographical errors and clarification to the permit requirement defining "leak-free" condition. These changes were minor and did not trigger additional public notification requirements, nor did they have any impact upon the Best Available Control Technology determination or on the amount of offsets required for project approval.
