**NOTICE OF PRELIMINARY DECISION
FOR THE ISSUANCE OF AUTHORITY TO CONSTRUCT AND
THE PROPOSED SIGNIFICANT MODIFICATION OF FEDERALLY
MANDATED OPERATING PERMIT**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the San Joaquin Valley Air Pollution Control District solicits public comment on the proposed significant modification of Aera Energy, LLC in the Belridge oil field in 2972 Setting in the NE/4 section 29, T28S, R21E, California. Aera has requested Authority to Construct (ATC) a new 100.0 MMBtu/hr natural gas-fired steam generator.

The District's analysis of the legal and factual basis for this proposed action, project #1121401 and 1121402, is available for public inspection at http://www.valleyair.org/notices/public_notices_idx.htm and at any District office. There are minor emission increases associated with this proposed action. This will be the public's only opportunity to comment on the specific conditions of the modification.
