**NOTICE OF PRELIMINARY DECISION
FOR THE ISSUANCE OF AUTHORITY TO CONSTRUCT AND
THE PROPOSED SIGNIFICANT MODIFICATION OF FEDERALLY
MANDATED OPERATING PERMIT**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the San Joaquin Valley Air Pollution Control District solicits public comment on the proposed significant modification of Berry Petroleum Company at the 21Z (McKittrick) lease, within Section 21, Township 30S, Range 22E, California. Berry Petroleum Company (Berry) has requested Authority to Construct (ATC) permits for two new 85 MMbtu/hr natural gas, ethane-rich natural gas and or TEOR gas-fired steam generators.

The District's analysis of the legal and factual basis for this proposed action, project #1133332, is available for public inspection at http://www.valleyair.org/notices/public_notices_idx.htm and at any District office. There are minor emission increases associated with this proposed action. This will be the public's only opportunity to comment on the specific conditions of the modification.
