**NOTICE OF PRELIMINARY DECISION
FOR THE ISSUANCE OF AUTHORITY TO CONSTRUCT AND
THE PROPOSED SIGNIFICANT MODIFICATION OF FEDERALLY
MANDATED OPERATING PERMIT**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the San Joaquin Valley Air Pollution Control District solicits public comment on the proposed significant modification of Occidental of Elk Hills at SE/4 Section 35, Township 30S, Range 22E, California. The project is to install an 85 MMBtu/hr natural gas/propane/TEOR-fired steam generator.

The District's analysis of the legal and factual basis for this proposed action, project #S-1133056, is available for public inspection at http://www.valleyair.org/notices/public_notices_idx.htm and at any District office. There are no emission increases associated with this proposed action. This project results in an emissions increase of 6,329 pounds of NOx, 2,122 pounds of SOx, 5,659 pounds of PM10, 16,381 pounds of CO, 4,468 pounds of VOC, and 39,389 tons of CO2 per year. This will be the public's only opportunity to comment on the specific conditions of the modification. If requested, the District will hold a public hearing regarding issuance of this modification.
