**NOTICE OF PRELIMINARY DECISION
FOR THE ISSUANCE OF AUTHORITY TO CONSTRUCT AND
THE PROPOSED SIGNIFICANT MODIFICATION OF FEDERALLY
MANDATED OPERATING PERMIT**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the San Joaquin Valley Air Pollution Control District solicits public comment on the proposed significant modification of Aera Energy LLC at Dehy 20 within the heavy and light oil production stationary sources in the Kern County field, California. The project authorizes installation of a 6,500 gallon chemical storage tank to be permitted in both S-1547 and S-1548 and resulting in an increase of 1512 lb VOC/yr.

This will be the public's only opportunity to comment on the specific conditions of the modification. If requested, the District will hold a public hearing regarding issuance of this modification.
