**NOTICE OF PRELIMINARY DECISION
FOR THE PROPOSED ISSUANCE OF
EMISSION REDUCTION CREDITS**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the San Joaquin Valley Unified Air Pollution Control District solicits public comment on the proposed issuance of Emission Reduction Credits to Occidental of Elk Hills, Inc. for the shutdown of the 35R gas plant and three IC engines driving gas compressors, at Sections 26 and 35, Township 30 South, Range 23 East. The quantity of ERCs proposed for banking is 60,076 lb-NOx/yr, 57 lb-SOx/yr, 3,994 lb-PM10/yr, 69,454 lb-CO/yr, and 49,531 lb-VOC/yr.
