**NOTICE OF PRELIMINARY DECISION
FOR THE PROPOSED ISSUANCE OF
EMISSION REDUCTION CREDITS**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the San Joaquin Valley Unified Air Pollution Control District solicits public comment on the proposed issuance of Emission Reduction Credits to Occidental of Elk Hills for the permanent shut down and removed of three 1680 BHP natural gas fired engines powering gas compressors (S-2234-207, '-208, and '-210), at Occidental's gas plant in Tupman. The quantity of ERCs proposed for banking is 516 lb-NOx/yr, 42 lb-SOx/yr, 2467 lb-PM10/yr, 3049 lb-CO/yr, and 296 lb-VOC/yr.
