

**NOTICE OF PRELIMINARY DECISION
FOR THE PROPOSED ISSUANCE OF
AN AUTHORITY TO CONSTRUCT**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the San Joaquin Valley Unified Air Pollution Control District solicits public comment on the proposed issuance of Authority to Construct to Frank N. Rocha Dairy LLP for the expansion of an existing dairy operation from a maximum capacity of 2,010 milk cows, not to exceed a combined total of 2,440 mature cows (milk and dry), 1,070 support stock (heifers and bulls), and 150 calves; to a maximum capacity of 3,000 milk cows, not to exceed a combined total of 3,430 mature cows (milk and dry), 1,580 support stock (heifers and bulls), and 150 calves; including the construction of four new freestall barns, at 23243 Lone Tree Rd, Escalon.
