**NOTICE OF FINAL DECISION
FOR THE ISSUANCE OF AUTHORITY TO CONSTRUCT AND
THE PROPOSED SIGNIFICANT MODIFICATION OF FEDERALLY
MANDATED OPERATING PERMIT**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the San Joaquin Valley Air Pollution Control District has made its final decision to issue Authorities to Construct to Berry Petroleum Company at the 21Z (McKittrick) lease, within Section 21, Township 30S, Range 22E, California, California. Berry Petroleum Company (Berry) has requested Authority to Construct (ATC) permits for two new 85 MMbtu/hr natural gas, ethane-rich natural gas and or TEOR gas-fired steam generators.

No comments were received following the District's preliminary decision on this project.
