**NOTICE OF PRELIMINARY DECISION
FOR THE ISSUANCE OF AUTHORITY TO CONSTRUCT AND
THE PROPOSED SIGNIFICANT MODIFICATION OF FEDERALLY
MANDATED OPERATING PERMIT**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the San Joaquin Valley Air Pollution Control District solicits public comment on the proposed significant modification of Occidental of Elk Hills, Inc at Elk Hills Oilfield, OEHI Light Oil Western Stationary Source, California. The facility is proposing to install a steam generator and Thermally Enhanced Oil Recovery system.

The District's analysis of the legal and factual basis for this proposed action, project #S-1134254, is available for public inspection at

http://www.valleyair.org/notices/public_notices_idx.htm and at any District office. The project results in an increase in the following emissions: NOx: 5,435 lb/year, SOx 2,122 lb/year, PM10: 5,659 lb/year, CO: 14,147 lb/year, and VOC: 7,027 lb/year.

This will be the public's only opportunity to comment on the specific conditions of the modification. If requested, the District will hold a public hearing regarding issuance of this modification. For additional information, please contact the District at (559) 230-6000.
